Wedding checklist

- **Fees.** Wedding fees are set centrally by the Archbishops' Council. The money goes towards the minister's stipend and the maintenance of the church. The fee for 2017 is £456. This includes the cost of the calling of banns and the provision of the marriage certificate.
- **Music.** St.Mark's choir will be pleased to support your wedding by leading the singing. The Vicar and Choirmaster are happy to advise you on the choice of hymns. You must consult with the organist, over the choice of incidental music.

The fees for choir and organist total £220, payable in cash in advance.

• **Photography.** The taking of still photographs in church is permitted, providing there is liaison in advance between the photographer and the Vicar.

As the words and music used at a wedding is copyright material, a licence is required before audio or video recordings are made. It is standard practice for performance fees to be increased when a recording is made.

There is, therefore, a surcharge of £220 if a video recording is to be made.

- **Bells.** There are no bells at St.Mark's.
